Waste Wise School, a program of the Waste Authority, provides teachers and support staff with professional development, curriculum materials and support for schools to help plan, implement and maintain sustainable waste minimisation projects. The first grant received will be for \$2200 and will go towards the cost of establishing a school worm farm.

Friday 20 July is an important date in your child's education.

You need to apply to enrol your children in a public school for 2019 if they are:

- starting Kindergarten – 4 years old by 30 June 2019
- starting Pre-primary (first year of compulsory school) – 5 years old by 30 June 2019
- starting Year 7 (first year of secondary school) changing schools.

All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their [local public school](#).

This week the children made pizza's.

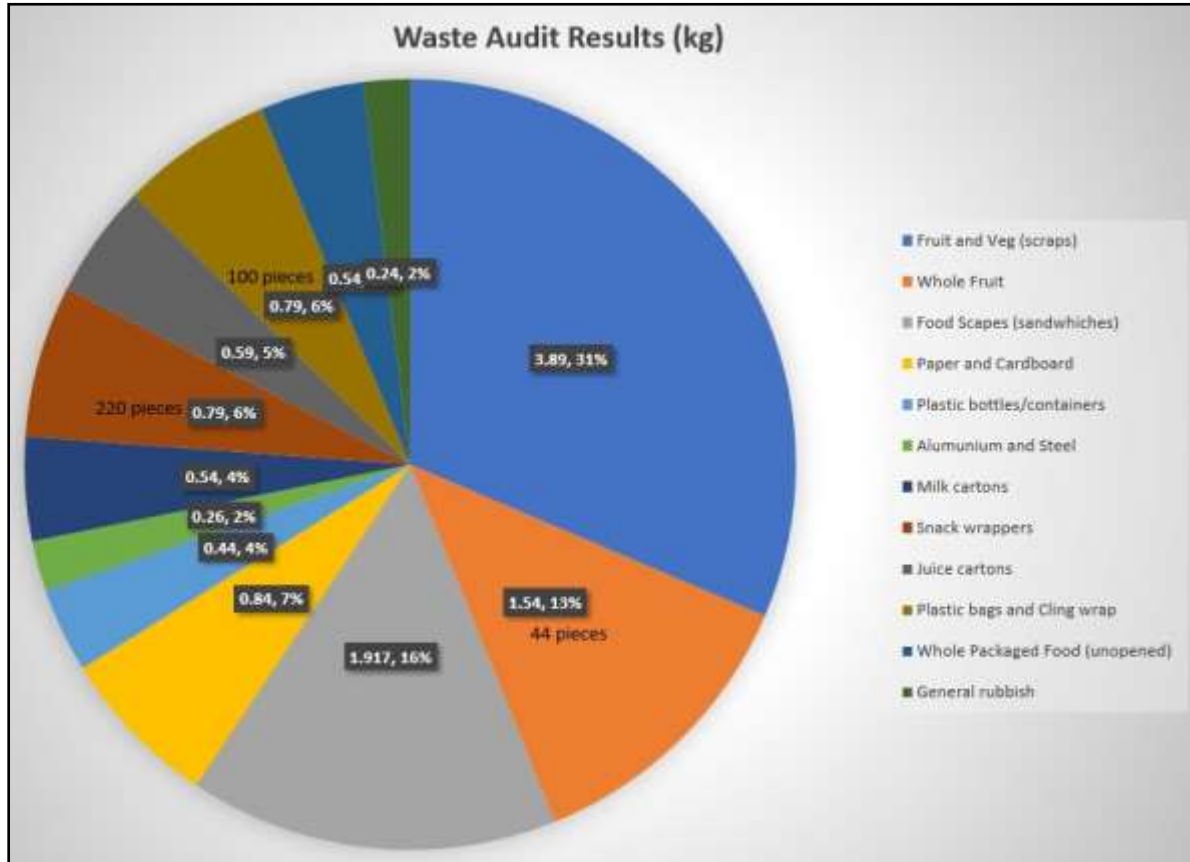
