M & M Monday Mindfulness and Meditation

Every Monday during lunchtime I run a mindfulness program with any child who wishes to attend. The library is darkened and we take some time to breathe, be mindful and follow simple meditations, always with a little energizer before we go back out into the playground.

There are some regulars who come every week and others who come when they remember. The program runs regardless of the number of children attending. I ensure that we only spend 10 – 15 minutes so there is always time left to go outside and play.

Meditation and mindfulness are important skills for children in the development of their mental health. It can help build resilience and reduce the severity of anxiety by helping them to cope better with stress and encourage them to engage more fully with themselves and the world.
