#### SUSTAINABILITY NEWS

Well done and thank you to everyone who participated in Trash Free Tuesdays. You have helped the school reduce waste. The class with the most improved waste free crunch, recess and lunch are:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> place D1 with 29% improvement
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place A2 with 32% improvement
- 1<sup>st</sup> place B1 with 37% improvement

We continued reducing the school's waste by having a new worm farm fridge installed. Organic scraps are collected and fed to the worms. The liquid and castings from the worm fridge will be used in the school's garden. **This project is funded by the State Government through the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Account, and administered by the Waste Authority.** <http://www.wasteauthority.wa.gov.au/>
