5.1	Principal's Report	Principal	MC informed the Board about the Data Club and how teaching staff are using this data from Elastik. MC gave a brief overview and explained what Elastik is. Staff have given good feedback about the data.	

			 SDD Frank Pansini from the Leadership Institute came to the school and presented to staff about Teacher for Impact. The Department has produced a document on a How to Teach in Classrooms. This is the first time the Department has produced anything like this. This will help in how we teach a whole school belief in teaching and learning. We are still developing this process. Public School Review is in February 2024 and MC spoke about how this will work. A brief discussion had about this review and how staff are implementing the procedures to make compliance. KPS is band 2 – means good students and good cliental. We are below/behind expected standard (benchmark) with like schools. PEAC testing happened for year 4. There was a new bike path laid in ECE. New gardens have been planted throughout the school. Science build – possibly the room near the library, this hasn't been finalized yet. Staff get to choose the furniture etc for the fit out. This room will need to used by the whole school so furniture and equipment needs to fitted so it is suitable for all ages. The school is an old school and there are a lot of things that need to be fixed or replaced but this issue is funding. MC spoke to Kim Giddens (Local Member) about these issues and MC is trying to see if she can come onto the Board as a Co-Opted member. MC spoke about staffing for next year and there are a few staff that will not be returning in 2024. MC explained how hard it is to get teachers and the department has changed how this process is done. MC discussed enrolment for next year and our numbers are increasing. This survey will be looked at in the first meeting in term 4. Does the survey need to conducted in term 4 to maybe get more results? Does there need to have target areas as a Board MC spoke about how we can get a comparison between the staff survey and the parent survey and look at the results. MC thanked TM for her hard work on the playground policy/statement that was sent out to parents. Sarah and Asiri have said they are willing to go onto the Engagement Committee.
